What is BYOD?

BYOD (Bring Your Own Device), refers to students bringing a personally-owned electronic communication device, e.g. laptop to school for the purpose of learning. Cronulla Public School recognises the need to prepare students for a rapidly-changing world where technology plays an increasing role in students' everyday lives.

In 2018, your child will be invited to bring a suitable learning device such as a laptop to school for learning purposes. We understand that these devices come at a cost. As such, we do not expect all students to arrive at school next year with devices. Students can join the program at any time once a device has been purchased.
