Timetable

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Uniforms

Kindergarten will be required to wear their school sports uniform every Wednesday and Friday and their normal school uniform on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday. Please ensure your child's name and class is clearly labelled on all their possessions e.g. jumpers, hats, shoes, drink bottles, lunch boxes, bags and crunch and sip containers. If your child loses an item please check their classroom, lost property (under the COLA) then ask the class teacher.

K-2 assemblies will continue to run every Friday at 2.30pm in the hall. Parents are more than welcome to attend.

Kindergarten Dance

This term, students in Kindergarten will be participating in weekly dance lessons as part of their learning. A trained dance teacher will teach students a range of skills and moves in order for them to perform a dance at the school's annual Night of Stars in Term 3. Students will not be required to wear sports uniform as this is only a half an hour lesson.

Modes of Communication

At Cronulla Public School we endeavour to provide parents and carers with as many modes of communication as possible. The school currently uses the following:

Newsletter – Sent out first Tuesday of every month

Notes – These are specific to an activity

School Website and Facebook pages – Contain photos and updates of what is happening in the school

Cronulla Catch-up – A weekly one-page document that outlines activities occurring and notes that have been sent home in the past week.

See-Saw – A dedicated Kindergarten page that allows parents to view their child's work and activities that are specific to Kindergarten. A note was placed in your First Day of Kindergarten envelope in Term 1. It is highly recommended that you join this page if you haven't already, as it gives great insight into what students are doing daily.
